

Twiddle- muff pattern

Muff Body:

Materials • This muff pattern is perfect for using up left over and odd balls of wool.

• Needles: 8mm circular or use 6.5mm straight needles- Size 3.

Cast on 40 stitches using 2 strands of double knitting wool, (you can also use 1 strand of chunky wool).

Work in stocking stitch (knit a line pearl a line knit) for 11 inches.

Then approx. 8 lines in reverse stocking stitch.

This makes the cuff at the other end of the Twiddler.

Continuing with stocking stitch and using up oddments of various textures of wool ie: chunky, mohair, ribbon.

Until work measures 23 inches.

Cast off.

Decoration and finishing

Now is the time if you want to decorate the muff body with beads, flowers, zips, loops, buttons, crochet or knit on a pocket and put something interesting to find there, keys wooden large play beads. Small teddy or doll. Make sure these are all really secure!

Neatly join side sides together with pearl side facing you.

Turn inside out.

Push the cast off end-line up inside the muff body so it is double walled tube .

Then sew together the cast on and cast off ends to make a sealed tube.
